

# NRA Instructor Class

**Nov. 11-13 2016**

**WHERE:** Camp Bud Schiele, Rutherfordton, NC

**WHO MAY ATTEND:** Any Venturer, Boy Scout, or Adult Registered BSA Leader. This course certifies you as an NRA instructor. The course does not allow you to take a troop to Camp Bud Schiele and open the ranges. Your certification **does allow** you to take a troop to a local range and sign off as a merit badge counselor for rifle or shotgun merit badges

**NRA PRE-QUALIFICATIONS:** A Pre-Qualification Test must be taken during the first ½ of class to determine your skill set level and a score of 80% must be achieved to be admitted to class. This score is not hard to achieve if you have had any previous shooting experience. NOTE: (These classes are open to all Venturing Youth regardless of previous shooting experience. Your score will not be a determining factor in your acceptance into this course)

**Note:** Prices quoted include ammunition and classroom materials. These prices are roughly half of the average being charged by area instructors throughout North Carolina for just regular classes, not Instructor Rating Certification classes.

**Prices do not include NRA membership fees or NRA certification fees**

Certification Requirements: Complete NRA Training Course

- NRA Certified Instructor : 21 years of age, score 90% or higher on written examination
- NRA Assistant Instructor: 18 years of age, score 85% or higher on written examination
- NRA Apprentice Instructor: 13 to 17 years of age, score 85% or higher on examination
- Pay the appropriate processing fee

**CREDENTIALING FEES**

All first time instructors, coaches, and range safety officers pay a flat credentialing fee of \$50 for a 2- year term. Additional ratings are added at a rate of \$20 per rating. Renewals are \$50 for a 2-year term regardless of how many ratings are being renewed.

NRA Member Benefit: credentialing fees are \$30 for a 2- year term. Additional ratings are added at a rate of \$10 per rating. Renewals are \$30 for a 2-year term regardless of how many ratings are being renewed.

Where trainers had both instructor and coach credentials expiring in different months/years, the closest date has been rolled up to the farthest date for the next renewal cycle. The ability to reprint certificates and ID cards with the extended expiration date occurred with the rollup.
